Please upload a description of your proposed research, structured in the following way: i) overarching research goal of project; ii) background/rationale (briefly stating current knowledge, major knowledge gaps, supporting preliminary data [as indicated]) – about 1/3 page; iii) main hypothesis/specific objective(s); iv) research methods/approach – including experimental plan, data analysis and potential pitfalls/limitations with mitigation measures; v) significance/KT/any future directions (if applicable) – about 1/3 page. The document should be two page maximum exclusive of reference, tables and/or figures; font size 12pt; one-inch margins.

Research Resources and Environment

Describe in half a page the key resources that are available to you to complete your research, how your supervisor/mentor's experience and track record is essential to help you achieve your career goals and support the feasibility of the proposed research.

Letters of Reference

Please provide the names of three individuals, preferably including your current department head, who have been asked to provide a letter of reference on your behalf. The proposed mentor must be one of the three. The letters of reference should highlight the candidate's strengths as they relate to suitability for research (e.g. creativity, technical aptitude, critical skills and judgement). The three letters of reference should be confidential and each letter sent directly from the reference to yunna.bystrova@micyrn.ca on or before the application deadline date.
